

Corona-Related Temporary Changes to the Statute of the University of Applied Sciences Kufstein Tirol

The regulations below apply until September 2021 and replace corresponding regulations in our statutes or the respective study regulations.

- **Deviation of Examination Modalities, Course Procedures, and Examination Dates:** Course leaders are entitled to deviate from the examination modalities and didactic concepts specified in the respective study regulations, so that courses and exams can be held (e.g. virtually). If possible, the changed modalities (examination, instruction) should be communicated to the students two weeks in advance. The two-week advance notification of the examination date must be observed. This deviation affects all types of examinations (e.g. board examinations, bachelor's and master's degree examinations, etc.). The final examination of courses should be administered before the end of the corresponding semester, if possible.
- **Semester Dates:** If class sessions are cancelled or postponed due to Covid-19-related circumstances, the winter semester 2020/2021 and the summer semester 2021 can be extended accordingly to ensure flexibility. This means that courses and exams can be offered at dates that are usually not included in academic scheduling (e.g. Easter or Pentecost). Naturally, the best possible attempt is made to run courses as planned and to support students in this. The Rectorate will communicate extensions to semester dates in good time.
- **Postponement of Courses and Semesters:** Courses from later semesters can be brought forward if administratively feasible, and courses that primarily require a presence can be postponed to subsequent semesters.
- **Admission to Bachelor Degree Examinations:** Conditional admission to the bachelor degree examination can be granted if all courses except the integrated professional internship have been successfully completed. Only upon successful completion of the professional internship is a successful bachelor degree examination considered completed and are degree program requirements considered fulfilled.
- **Election of Faculty Representatives:** The members of the Council of the University of Applied Sciences and its leadership remain in their function until the next council election.
- **Virtual Participation in Council Meetings:** Council meetings can also be attended virtually. Virtual participation is considered equivalent to personal participation with all the resulting rights and obligations.
